God's Mercy and Wrath

Radio Broadcast for week of May 4, 1969 (See back page for list of stations.)

... we are happy to be coming your way once again, friends, with another message of salvation. We are glad for the new listeners who have taken the time to write us, and for those who have not done so may I say if you get a blessing from the message we would be happy to hear from you. We appreciate those who help share the responsibility of keeping the message on the air. Here is the way to address your letter: THE MISSION TRAIL, Guthrie, Okla. This is Willie Murphey speaking. Now I hope that you are familiar with the theme song that you hear from Sunday to Sunday here on the broadcast. Would you like to hear a little more of it? Listen.

Friends, do not the words of that song present to you a challenge with a greater desire to do more for Christ than you have ever done before. Just think of it. Today even in this enlightened age in which we live there are many who are yet lingering in the shadows of darkness bound by the shackles of sin waiting for the gospel message to set them free. Let us be faithful in proclaiming God's word.

Here now is our scripture reading. From Rom. 11:22, "Behold therefore the goodness and severity of God: on them which fell, severity; but toward thee, goodness, if thou continue in his goodness: otherwise thou also shalt be cut off. " Since God is a spirit they that worship him must worship him in spirit and in truth. We should also understand more about him. Some folks think of God as being full of love and mercy and that is true. But they seem to feel that if he is a God of love and mercy then he is just going to let people do as they please and he is going to love them just the same. Well, God does love everyone. That is true, but be sure of this one thing that God is concerned about the way people live and act and although he loves them this does not prevent the judgments of God from coming their way when they disobey him.

Here then are some of the attributes and also a description of God's nature. First, he is a spirit as I have mentioned already, and next he is declared to be invisible, eternal, immortal, incorruptible, omnipotent, omnipresent, omniscient, immutable, the only wise He is incomprehensible, unsearchable and most high. God is love and is perfect. He is also holy, just, true, upright, righteous, good, great, gracious, faithful, merciful, long suffering, and compassionate. And yet God is a jealous God. He is heart searching, and a consuming fire. He is the owner of all things, the controller of nature, the giver of law and bestows grace as he sees best. He is also the

executor of judgment upon men and nations.

Furthermore the word of Godis likened to a fire, a hammer, a sword, a whirlwind, a rod, a lamp, and a looking glass. The word of God is true and powerful. It was through his word that God framed the worlds. And please be informed that God's word has declared that the earth shall be destroyed not by water but by fire. It was God's word which overthrew Sodom and Go-His word is immutable, it morrah. shall never be broken, it shall never pass away. It shall abide forever and it is forever settled in heaven. Friends, God is not changeable as many of the people in the world these days. These are only a few of the things which the scriptures declare which God is. Listen to this poem which further describes the nature of God.

The Infinity of God

Holy and infinite! Viewless, Eternal! Veiled in the glory that none can sustain,
None comprehendeth thy being supernal,
Nor can the heaven of heavens contain.

Holy and Infinite! Limitless, boundless,
All thy perfections and power and praise!
Ocean of mystery! awful and soundless,
All thine unsearchable judgments and ways!

King of Eternity! what revelation Could the created and finite sustain, But for thy marvelous manifestation, Godhead incarnate in weakness and pain! Therefore archangels and angels adore thee,

Cherubim wonder, and seraphs admire:

Therefore we praise thee, rejoicing before thee,

Joining in rapture the heavenly choir.

Glorious in holiness, fearful in praises, Who shall not fear thee, and who shall not laud?

Anthems of glory thy universe raises, Holy and Infinite! Father and God!

Next I would like to speak to you specifically about the mercy of God. You see his mercy is great. In fact it says so right here in Psa. 52:8, "But I am like a green olive tree in the house of God: I trust in the mercy of God for ever and ever. " And over in Psa. 108: 4 we find these words, "For they mercy is great above the heavens: and thy truth reacheth unto the clouds." In fact it is summed up in Psa. 119:64 like this, "The earth, O Lord, is full of thy mercy: teach me thy statutes." I Peter 1:3 speaks about the mercy of God in this way, "Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, which according to his abundant mercy hath begotten us again unto a lively hope by the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead". And then in Eph. 2:4 "But God, who is rich in mercy, for his great love wherewith he loved us," But just listen to this verse from II Cor. 1:3, "Blessed be God, even the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of mercies, and the God of all comfort".

Now someone might be inquisitive enough to ask, "Well, if God is all that merciful why does he not manifest himself in a more significant manner?" Friends, I declare to you that God does manifest his mercy. He does it over

and over again each day of our lives and some folks just don't seem to realize how merciful the Lord is. Here is one of the greatest ways in which God's mercy and love is manifested and that is in redeeming from sin and destruction those who repent of their evil ways. Psa. 130 and verse 7 reads, "Let Israel hope in the Lord: for with the Lord there is mercy, and with him is plenteous redemption. " Listen to these words from Acts 17:27-28, "That they should seek the Lord, if haply they might feel after him, and find him, though he be not far from every one of us: For in him we live, and move, and have our being; as certain also of your own poets have said, For we are also his offspring." Now, friends, doesn't that manifest the love and mercy of God? Everything that we have, every good gift and every perfect gift is from above and cometh down from the father of light. So the Lord is merciful to us. We should not forget that. It is through him and by him that we are able to live and breathe and move about and have the use of our mind and limbs. think what it might be if the Lordwere to withhold his mercy from us.

But do you know what kind of people God especially takes delight in showing mercy to? It is those folks who fear him. Luke 1:50 puts it this way, "And his mercy is on them that fear him from generation to generation." So, you see, his mercy just continues on and on to those who fear the Lord.

Shall we pray,

Our gracious, merciful, and righteous Father.

We humbly acknowledge our need of thee and in doing so we seek for thy blessings to accompany the message and we also seek for mercy to be shown to every listener of the broadcast and in receiving of thy mercy may we in turn have compassion and be long suffering with others and to thee we will give the praise through Christ our Lord. Amen
